- Divers must have participated in two Seven Hills League meets during the 2011 summer season in order to be eligible for Championships
- **Each participating club will provide one judge; Turpin will provide a judge and the referee.** Please see page 20 of the league rules. This judge should not be a parent from your team – this is a paid position.

Items to Review Before the Meet

- **League Rules:** Please see Appendix D for League Rules on League website: <http://www.7hillsleague.org>. However, dive requirements to both meets and championships are attached.
- **Diving Sheets:** Every representative received the E-dive program in June. **E-Dive entries are due by noon on Sunday, July 3.** Changes may be made up to a half hour of the diver's event; however try to make all changes and scratches on Sunday night before or after your warm up. - **T-shirts:** Attached is a pre-order form for t-shirts. T-shirts will *primarily* be available on a pre-order basis. - **Program Ads:** Attached is an order form for anyone wishing to place an ad in the championship program. Please send or bring completed order forms with payment to Turpin Swim Club by July 1. - **Volunteers:** Each club needs to provide one table workers for each age group, both boys and girls. Your list of volunteers must be mailed or emailed to Sue Richardson at www.susanmrichardson@earthlink.net. Table workers will be used as ribbon writers and helpers at the table should there be any glitches with e-dive. Your table workers need to work during dual meets. Please encourage their involvement. Champs is not the time to have a first time worker.
- **Team Area:** There will be a marked area for each team on the deck.
- **Awards Ceremonies:** After each event, the top 3 divers will proceed to the awards stand to be presented with medal. Places 4 – 12 will receive ribbons; this is to stay consistent with the swim awards. Following awards, there will be a brief opportunity for photos from families.
- **Parking:** directions will be provided at the meet. There will be a designated diver drop off area. We recommend car pooling. The black top and grassy area will be used by all. However, a “special” grassy area in the back will be marked off for coaches, team parent, and coaches/judges. You will enter the back door free of charge.
- **Hospitality:** Judges, coaches and volunteer workers will be provided with free drinks, snacks and lunch.
- **Concessions:** Open all day with breakfast and lunch selections as well as baked goods and grilled food.

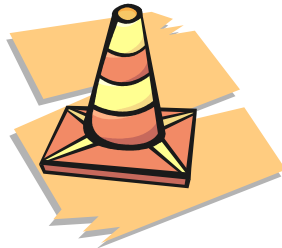

APPENDIX D

7-Hills League Diving Championship Meet
Dive Requirements

<i>Age Groups</i>	<i>Preliminaries (Cut to 12 after Preliminaries)</i>	<i>Finals</i>
8 and Under	One Required Dive, One Optional Dive (Divers must represent TWO categories within three dives)	One Optional Dive
10 and Under	One Required Dive, One Optional Dive (Divers must represent TWO categories within four dives)	One Required Dive One Optional Dive
12 and Under	Two Required Dives, One Optional Dive (Divers must represent THREE categories within five dives)	One Required Dive One Optional Dive
14 and Under	Two Required Dives, One Optional Dive (Divers must represent THREE categories within five dives)	One Required Dive One Optional Dive
18 and Under	Two Required Dives, Two Optional Dives (Divers must represent FOUR categories within six dives)	One Required Dive One Optional Dive

NOTES:

- (A) Only the one-meter board can be used during the Diving Championship Meet.
- (B) All diving events are for both boys and girls.
- (C) No dives performed in the preliminaries shall be repeated in the finals.
- (D) There are FIVE categories of dives: Forward Dives, Back Dives, Reverse Dives, Inward Dives and Twisting Dives. NOTE: A back twisting dive is NOT considered a “back” category dive – it is considered a “twisting” category dive.
- (E) Required dives are defined by number from the US Diving Rule Book Degree of Difficulty Tables: Forward dive - #101; Back dive - #201; Reverse dive - #301; Inward dive - #401; Half Twist - #511. Required dives must be performed prior to the optional dives.
- (F) The Position of the dive is also defined in the US Diving Rulebook: “A” – Straight or Layout Position; “B” – Pike Position; “C” – Tuck Position; “D” Free Position
- (G) All optional dives must be from a different group. (Example: A diver cannot perform both a Forward 1 ½ somersault AND a Forward double somersault.)
- (H) Any “required” dive not used as a “required” dive may be used as an “optional” dive. Any dive not defined as a “required” dive is considered an optional dive. “Optional” dives may NOT be used as “required” dives
- (I) The finals will be restricted to the twelve boys and twelve girls accumulating the highest number of points in the diving preliminaries, in each age group. In the event of a “tie” for 12th place, both divers will be permitted to dive in the Finals for a total of 13 divers.
- (J) Properly completed dive sheets should have the correct dive number and position letter as well as the written description of the dive in the spaces provided. The Dive Number and Position Letter are the OFFICIAL description of the dive
- (K) Jumping off the board is not permitted at Diving Championships.
- (L) Exhibition Divers are NOT permitted at the Diving Championship Meet.

VI Championship – Diving

1. Appendix: Age group diving requirements for championships for championships are listed in Appendix D.
2. Admission
 - A The admission fee for the Diving championships will be:
 1. Under 6 years old – No Charge
 2. 6 – 15 years old - \$1.00
 3. Over 15 years old - \$2.00

The money collected will be used by the host club to offset meet expenses.

- B Coaches, divers and hired Officials only will not be charged an admission fee. Spectators and volunteer officials must pay the admission fee.
 - C Program fees for Diving Championships are used to offset the cost of printing and hosting the meet and are kept by the host club. These programs may not be sold for more than **\$2.00**. (8/2009)

3. Times/dates:

Diving will consist of one day of events. Both boys and girls will compete on the one meter board only. Diving championships will be scheduled for the Monday of the week of Swimming Championships. The competition will start no later than 3:00 pm on Monday. Diving competition will be held during daylight hours, if feasible.

4. Equipment

Championships will be run by the host club as generally specified in this section. This procedure will supplement but not replace other sections of these rules. All equipment required to efficiently operate the meet will be available. This includes but is not limited to:

Chairs for Judges

Tables for scorers

Diving flash cards (one set per judge)

USA Diving score book or equivalent with degree of difficulty.

Spectator and team areas defined so as not to interfere with the operation of the meet.

5. Personnel

- A Each participating club will provide one diving judge with the host club providing two judges. The host club may hire judges from outside the league if it desires. See USA Diving Rules for scoring method.
- B Each club will provide one scorer and one ribbon writer.
- C The host club shall provide the Referee from outside the league. The Referee will be responsible for calling the diving meet because of bad weather and resolving any other situations.

6. Judging

See USA Diving rules for usual judging guidelines.

7. Scoring

Diving Points will be awarded as follows:

8. Awards

The League is responsible for the purchase of awards.

- A Medals for 1st-3rd places
- B Ribbons for 4th through 12th places
- C Team age group plaques will be awarded in all age groups (one for boys and one for girls). Age group winners will be determined by totaling points scored in each age group. These awards will be delivered to the appropriate clubs no later than two weeks after the Championships.
- D A trophy (or plaque) will be awarded to the winning team for permanent possession. The trophy or plaque will cost from \$25.00 to \$40.00.
- E A traveling trophy provided by the league will be awarded to the winning team. Current engraving of this trophy and its return to the next year's diving championship is the responsibility of the winning team. Replacement for a lost or damaged traveling trophy is the responsibility of the team in possession. It is recommended that the meet director of the current diving championship host club call the diving coach or diving representative of the previous year's champion and determine the procedure to hand over the traveling trophy.

9. Postponement

Should the Diving Championships be halted before completion, the make-up day will be Tuesday, the next day.

10. Entries

- (A) There shall be no limit to the number of divers that may participate in the diving Preliminaries.
- (B) A diver must have participated in two dual meets or one dual meet and a properly scored intrasquad to qualify for the championships. Swimming meets do not qualify for the diving championships. Each coach is responsible for retaining a copy of the official results for each dual meet

and/or the intrasquad meet and must be able to prove eligibility requirements of the divers.

- (C) Each age group of divers will complete all of their Preliminary and Finals dives, before starting the next age group of divers.
- (D) Diving finals will be restricted to the twelve boys and 12 girls accumulating the highest number of points in the diving Preliminaries in each age group. The points accumulated by each diver in the Preliminaries will be carried forward to the Finals.
- (E) The host club shall hold all diving sheets for one week after the Finals are completed. During this time, any coach may examine the sheets at the host club.

11. Positions

- (A) Entry sheets for diving must be turned in to the host club no later than one week before the Championship Meet. A cover sheet should accompany each club's entry sheets which lists all divers for which entry sheets are attached. Entry sheets should be filled out by coaches in black ink (for accuracy, consistency, and copying purposes). Changes will be accepted one hour prior to the start of Preliminaries and until ½ hour after the start of the 11-12 preliminaries. The final list of dives must be signed by the diving coach, who is responsible for the correctness of the diving list.
- (B) Dive numbers should be on the entry sheets to verify the exact dive for the Judges.
- (C) The Referee or his/her representative shall inspect all diving sheets. Should the sheets be incorrect, or not in accordance with the rules, the Referee shall note all discrepancies and shall publicly announce which sheets are in error. Coaches will be allowed up to ½ hour before the official starting time of the Preliminaries of that age group to correct the error(s). Any error(s) not corrected are the responsibility of the coach, with the so-affected diver will be penalized as set forth in these rules.
- (D) The diving order for the Preliminaries will be established by lot. The diving order for the finals will be the same as established in the Preliminaries with the eliminated divers' sheets removed.

12. Change of Age Group

A diver must compete in his/her own age group.

13. Exhibition

No exhibition events or divers are permitted in Championships.

14. Team Areas

Each participating club will be responsible for cleaning up its assigned area at the completion of the meet.
